(Regarding what I and the precious, God have mercy upon her (TN:
a female who passed away), this is our duty and, God willing, I
will continue until God grant you a good woman. I feel that I
did not provide you or your dad and mom anything. I feel that I
am shortcoming). I would like to say may God reward you, and
your effort is appreciated.

You, my brother and my sister, have gotten me a fiancé, and an
agreement was granted. You also have asked for a fiancé from my
dad, and an agreement was granted.

There is nothing else to do, except praying to God.

My brother, glory to God! I and my dad have tried many times to
bring you in here before my sister's death, God have mercy upon
her. However, there is a problem that prevented us from doing
so, and it is the same problem that is preventing me from
getting married now. I ask God to grant us a solution, and God
is capable of doing so.
